

Hallowell Boat Launch

Town Permitting Summary

The planning board approved the redesign of the parking area and the replacement of the boat ramp on June 19, 2019. The findings of fact were signed on August 21, 2019 and no conditions were placed on the original permit. Since construction of the facility in 1971, parking space standards have changed due to an increase in the size of boats and towing vehicles.

To accommodate larger vehicles and provide ADA access, the parking area redesign included an increase in the size and number of the rig parking spaces. The traffic pattern in the parking area was changed to improve maneuverability within the site. Currently, there are 8 rig parking spaces at the boat launch. The redesign allows for 9 rig parking spaces and 1 ADA rig parking space, along with 5 standard vehicle spaces and 1 ADA space.

The replacement of the boat ramp includes replacing planks, repairing base materials; and repairing/replacing the surrounding riprap materials.

We are applying for an amendment for the installation of an accessible boarding float system to improve loading and unloading of boats. This float system will include a concrete abutment above high water, three removable piles, and a set of floats.
