



#### Items

1. Additions to the Agenda – none at the beginning of the meeting.
2. Minutes to September 11, 2019 meeting approved by consensus. There was one correction noted. The person who is helping draft our age friendly plan is Yacor Aviv. The names were reversed in the minutes. He goes by “Aviv.” More information about Aviv is in item 6 Age-Friendly Plan.
3. Reports on Events – Maggie and Bob attended the Spectrum Generations Focus Group and the Wisdom Summit. Maggie thought the focus group was specifically about the Cohen Center, so she was disappointed. The discussion was about Spectrum Generations and how it served the community. The Wisdom Summit featured a variety of vendor displays, general session presentations and afternoon breakout sessions
4. Newsletter Update – The newsletter was distributed beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>. Comments thus far have been most favorable. The November meeting will include a more detailed review.
5. Fire/Falls and Fraud Prevention – Hallowell Fire Department Open House - October 12<sup>th</sup> Chief Owens and Chief Nason.
6. Age-Friendly Plan – Patricia Oh introduced Yacov Aviv to Hallowell and Bob McIntire. Aviv is willing to help draft the Hallowell All Age-Friendly Plan. has worked as a free-lance musician and in college administration at Berklee College of Music. Sounds like a natural fit in Hallowell! He received an MA in Positive Developmental Psychology and Evaluation Science from Claremont Graduate University in 2014. Since then he has been working at the Maine Crisis Hotline. Recently he has started attending the University of New England in the Master of Social Work program and is working with Patricia Oh.
7. Partner Agreements – Catholic Charities - Transportation/Companion Volunteers. City Manager Nate Rudy is reviewing the agreement with Catholic Charities.
