**PAPER**

4 categories

**1. CARDBOARD-Flattened!**

corrugated cardboard & moving boxes  
 paper egg cartons  
 shoe boxes  
 cereal, tissue boxes  
 cardboard 6 pack holders

**2. OFFICE PAPER**

stationery & office paper (*any color or size; shredded or not*)  
 photocopies  
 yellow-lined paper  
 computer printout paper  
 envelopes (*any color or size; OK to leave windows in*)

**3. NEWSPRINT**

newspapers only (*not slick inserts*)

**4. MIXED PAPER**

all newspaper inserts  
 brown paper bags  
 slick, stiff or glossy paper  
 waxed paper  
 coated cardboard (*e.g. milk cartons*)  
 magazines  
 phone books  
 catalogs & Uncle Henry's  
 junk mail  
 miscellaneous other paper (*neither 'cardboard' nor 'office paper'*)

**PLASTICS**

categories based on # in Δ on item

LOOK on plastic items for a raised triangle with number from 1 thru 7 inside the triangle.

If you do not find a 1 or 2, put in bin for opaque plastics numbered #2 - #7

***NO bulky plastics or rigid plastic items accepted, except for buckets of 5 gal or less.***

**1. CLEAR PLASTICS #1 only**

See-through, very clear colorless & colored plastics such as:

#1 lids & containers  
 (#1 plastic is often used for containers of store-bought pastries, cut up fruits & veggies, etc. and for leftovers and take-out food)

non-returnable #1 plastic bottles

**2. CLOUDY PLASTICS #2 only**

#2 water & milk jugs (*cloudy plastic only*). Please put all other #2 (solid white & solid colored) in with mixed opaques.

**3. MIXED OPAQUES #2 - #7**

Opaque solid white & solid colored plastics: #2 thru #7, such as:  
 molded opaque plastic containers (*like containers used for yogurt, detergents, household products, frozen dinners, etc.*)

**METALS**

1 category

**1. TIN & ALUMINUM**

cans for soup, sauce, fruits & vegetables, etc.  
 pet food cans  
 aluminum cans  
 covers & lids  
 clean aluminum foil  
 aluminum/tin pie plates  
 soda, beer cans

**ITEMS THAT CAN NOT BE RECYCLED HERE:**

Ceramic dishes or pottery

Bulky items - such as plastic chairs, plastic toys or pools, furniture or lamps

Styrofoam

Batteries (of any kind)

Lightbulbs (of any kind)

Hardcover books - unless hard covers have been removed

Plastic bags

Plate glass

**GLASS**

2 categories based on appearance

**1. CLEAR & TINTED GLASS**

Clear & tinted or colored glass jars & glass bottles

**PLEASE - NO WINDOW PANES;**

**NO MIRRORS & NO WINDSHIELD GLASS.**

**Gently place glass** in bin to minimize broken glass.

Thank you for reducing waste & conserving natural resources.
