

**CITY OF HALLOWELL
PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

Relating to Signs

Proposed Ordinance Rewrite Committee Amendments in Red

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hallowell that Subsection 2 F of Section 9-637 of the Revised Code of Ordinances, City of Hallowell (1997) is amended as follows:

SECTION 9-637 SIGNS

2. F. Signs Unrelated to Goods or Services Not Available on the Premises. Except for directional signs permitted by the Maine Travelers Information Services Act, all signs shall relate to goods or services directly available on the premises on which the sign and business is/are located. Temporary contractor signs may be installed without a permit, provided the following conditions are met:

- (1) A valid building, plumbing, demolition, or other permit has been issued for the property on which the sign is to be located.
- (2) The aggregate square footage, per face, of any temporary signs shall not exceed thirty-two (32) square feet, **except in the Historic District, where the aggregate square footage per sign face shall not exceed sixteen (16) square feet.**
- (3) The sign shall not be placed more than seven (7) calendar days prior to the start of work and shall be removed within seven (7) days of the completion of the work.
