<p>Mixed paper (examples)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - junk mail - non corrugated "cardboard" - magazines - paper milk/juice cartons - coated papers - catalogues <p>Office Paper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - shredded or whole <p>Newsprint</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - newspapers - some catalogues <p>Cardboard</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>Flattened Corrugated cardboard only</u> <p>Cardboard is placed in the outdoor dumpsters on the right (south) side of the Public Works building.</p>	<p>* Look for number in plastic recycling symbol (triangle)</p> <p>#1 Clear PP, PET, PETE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - clear takeout, see-through, and leftover containers - see-through clear lids and covers - non returnable clear plastic bottles <p>#2 Mixed Cloudy HDPE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Milk containers, and other similar containers <p>#2-7 Mixed Opaque HDPE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - molded opaque containers for detergents, other household products and plant containers - opaque plastic food containers for yogurt, frozen dinners, etc. 	<p>Tin and Aluminum</p> <p>Includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pet food cans - tin cans for soups, sauces, fruits and vegetables - aluminum cans - lids from jars and cans - clean aluminum foil - aluminum and tin pie plates - soda and beer cans 	<p>Clear and Colored</p> <p>Includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - jars - bottles - window panes <p>No plate glass, mirrors or broken glass. These must go to the landfill.</p>
		<p>Important</p> <p>All items must be clean and free of food. Labels do not need to be removed from cans.</p>	<p>Important</p> <p>Ceramic dishes and pottery may not be recycled at North Bay. Just one piece will contaminate the whole bin.</p>
